We will be exploring British Values and all the routines of the classroom in an exciting way. Our topic will then be Once Upon A Time. We will explore different fairy tales, authors and stories.

Home Learning – This term's home learning is to do a project about Great Britain. This can be done in any way the children would like. For example, they could do a poster, some writing, retelling a story, picture, PowerPoint or a model of a famous British person, group or building. An example of this could be about a British King or Queen, a famous British object (like a bowler hat or red telephone box) or an event (like Bonfire Night). This will be due in during the week after half term on **Friday 6th November.**

If you or a member of your family take a holiday within the UK, it would be lovely if you could send Beech class a postcard to add to our British Values display.

Please can your child bring their PE kit every day. This can be left on their peg. **Miss Guy** teaches PE on Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons. **Mrs Cornish** will be teaching ICT on a Tuesday and **Mr Harley** will be teaching Science on a Wednesday. Year 1 and 2 will have a Forest School session every other Thursday afternoon.

Homework

Reading	Please read with your child regularly as this will have an impact on your child's learning. We
	change the children's Home Reading books every Monday and Thursday. Your child's book
	and book bag will be needed in school everyday for 1:1 reading. You may like to add a
	positive or helpful comment in the reading diary but please acknowledge the fact that the
	book has been read by signing and dating in the comments book. There will be stickers given
	out for children who read at home regularly. I have attached some ideas for comments.
Spellings	We will be sending home weekly spellings on a Friday , these will be stuck in the front of their
	new spelling books. Please help your child to learn these words. There will be a fun spelling
	quiz on the following Wednesday.
Maths	We will send this out on a Friday and this needs to be back in school on the following Friday .
	Times tables: Please can the children LEARN THEIR TIMES TABLES off by heart, in order, out of
	order. Music CDs with times tables are helpful – if you need any ideas with how to help your
	child please ask me. Miss Jayne will be teaching the children times table songs which
	hopefully your children will be able to share with you!

Reminders – Please can you make sure your child brings in a water bottle each day.

Show and tell – if your child has any books or objects linked to *Great Britain* these can be shared with the class.

If you need to speak to me, either **Miss Pryce** or I will aim to be on the playground everyday at 8:45am. Please see **Mrs Heywood** or me if you would like to make an appointment to see me.
