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Sports Day 2016

Parents mentioned that it would be good if there were arrangements made for extra parking on sports day.

Parent also asked if the activities in sports day could last a similar length of time so there is not much waiting time during the carousel activities. The school would take this into consideration when deciding on the activities to choose.
