Chloe (Oak) - for writing a fantastic story using champion sentences about a purple cat!



#### HM Queen's 90th Birthday Celebration Day

On **Friday 10th June**, Chiddingly School will be holding a special day to celebrate Queen Elizabeth's 90th Birthday. All around the country there will be a large number of street parties and events and we plan to bring this special occasion to school.

During the day, we will be holding lots of special activities, celebrating the life of the Queen and reflecting further on the British Values that we share in our school. We will be singing songs, taking part in 'Royal' themed activities and holding a large street party banquet style lunch on the playground.

We are very fortunate that our MP, Nus Ghani, has accepted our invitation to join us at Chiddingly for a short time to share in our celebration.

To calebrate this special event, we ask that the children come to school dressed in red, white and blue clothing. There will also be another 'Great British Childdingly Bake Off', where children, parents and staff can share their artistic talents. The theme this year is 'Creative British Cupcakes'. At 3pm, parents and carers are invited to a special celebration in the school hall where the children will share their activities from the day and the prizes for the 'Chiddingly Bake Off' will be presented.
