Dear Parents & Carers

Breakfast Club runs every weekday (term time only) at 7.45am to 8.30am in the school hall. If you would like your child to attend Breakfast Club, the cost is £5 per session.

If you are booking more than one child into Breakfast Club for 6 sessions a week or more, we can now offer a 10% discount for multiple bookings.

We offer the children cereals, toast and a drink. Please ensure that your child brushes their teeth before coming to the club.

If you would like your child to attend, please complete the attached form and return it to the school office. As you will appreciate, we need to make advance provision for the food, so we request that you make the payment with your booking. If this is not possible for you, please speak to me about setting up a payment plan.

In exceptional circumstances, we can accept single visits to the club, for example, if you have a last minute medical appointment and need your child to start school earlier for one day. However, if this is the case please ensure that you let the office know as soon as possible. Please also provide the £5 payment in a clearly labelled envelope and the information on the attached slip.


