It has been a busy and productive 2 terms for the partnership schools. We have had a shared INSET and teachers have regularly planned, moderated and shared work with each other.


In the new year we will write to parents explaining the benefits of being in the partnership for pupils and staff and address any frequently asked questions about partnership developments.

Dear Parents & Carers

Breakfast Club runs every weekday (term time only) at 7.45am to 8.30am in the school hall. If you would like your child to attend Breakfast Club, the cost is £5 per session.
