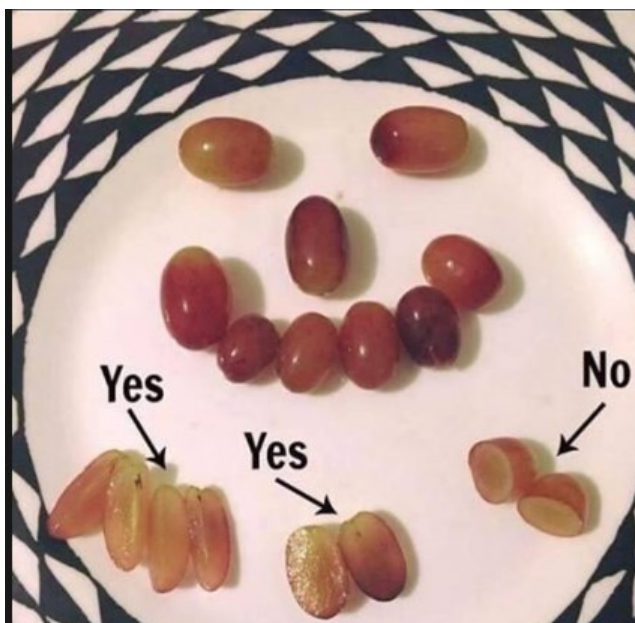

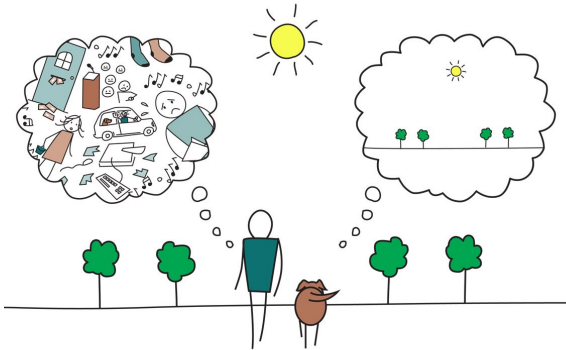
Grapes

Willow Class Outdoor Learning Day

As a result of many parents' interest in an outdoor learning trip, and to extend and develop Year 3 & 4's outdoor, physical and team building learning, we have arranged for them to go on an outdoor activity day at Walton Firs Activity Centre in Cobham on **Tuesday 23rd January**.

The activities we have booked for all the children to take part in are:

- Caving
- Adventure Course
- Crate Stacking
- Nightline

We will be leaving school at 8am and will return to school around 4.30pm and the children will need to bring a **packed lunch and water bottle** with them.

The children **WILL** get muddy and they need warm, active, movable trousers, trainers, jumper, waterproofs and a backpack with a complete spare change of clothes. Long hair needs to be tied back, we will send a reminder of this information before the trip.

The cost of this day will be £24.10 per child, this includes the cost of all the instructed activities and our coach travel to and from Walton Firs.

Due to the nature of the activities, we would be very grateful for some parent helpers to assist with a group through the day. Please could you indicate on the form below whether you are able to attend this trip with us. As we are going on a coach with limited seating, this will be on a first come, first served basis.

We are aware that it this trip has been arranged after an expensive time of year and are therefore providing two payment options:

1. You can pay the full amount of £24.10 by **Monday 22nd January**.
2. You can pay a deposit amount of £10 by **Friday 12th January** and the remaining balance of £14.10 by **Monday 22nd January**.
