Dear Pioneer Families,

We would like to explain the leadership structure across the Pioneer Federation from September 2018.

There will always be a member of the leadership team (Executive Headteacher, Head of School, Assistant Headteacher or Senior Teacher) in charge of the school daily. They will not be class based when leading the school. Please feel that you can meet with any of the leaders to discuss issues or concerns. The leadership team meet regularly so all information will be shared between us all.

James Procter will continue as Executive Headteacher across the 3 schools. He will be working at each school equally across the week and will be the key leader in charge of the school on the days he is in. James has the National Headteacher qualification.

Vicky Lewis will be the Head of School for Chiddingly and East Hoathly. She will split her time equally across both schools. Vicky will be the key leader in charge of the school on the days she is in. Vicky has had a vast range of leadership training and experience and has been the Deputy Headteacher for the schools over the last few years.

Frances Taylor will be the Head of School for St Mary's for 4 days a week. Frances will be the key leader in charge of the school on the days she is in. Frances has also had a vast range of leadership training and experience and has previously been a Deputy and an Acting Headteacher.

Lisa Purcell will be the Assistant Headteacher for East Hoathly and Claire Winchester will be the Assistant Headteacher for Chiddingly. They will be out of class for 1 day a week and will be in charge of the school on that day. Lisa and Claire have had a wide range of leadership training and experience.

Sheridan Denney is the EYFS Lead and Senior Teacher for East Hoathly and will occasionally be the key leader in charge of East Hoathly. She oversees Early Years at East Hoathly and is also an EYFS County moderator. She has had a range of leadership training and experience. Dawn Poulton is the Nursery Manager and leads the Nursery.

Sian Leahy will be the Inclusion Manager at St Mary's for 1 day a week. She will also be the Thrive Lead across all 3 schools and will be working in each school for half a day each month.

Sally McGinty and Sophie Levey are the Inclusion Managers for Chiddingly and East Hoathly respectively. They both also work one day a week in this role.

The names of Pioneer Governors and their responsibilities will be sent out soon.

We all look forward to working with you to ensure that your children have the best educational experience possible and that the Federation continues to flourish.


