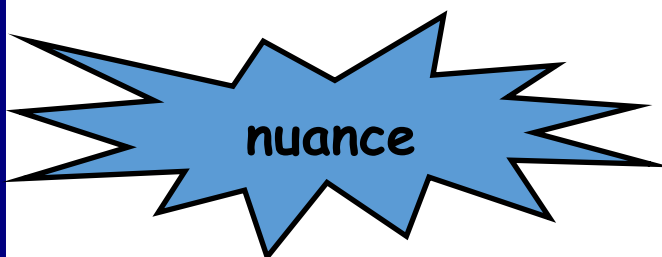


Punctuality
