We also need to say thank you to R W Green tree surgeons and Forest Tree Surgeons for providing all the bark chippings that were used for the base of the outside classroom. Over the past three years we have seen the pond area transform into the beautiful space we now have. Our pond still suffers from duck weed but Mr Herdman managed to source a lot of free pond plants so we are hoping this helps create more balance to the water so the children are able to pond dip more easily. Dear Parents & Carers
