


They would like to raise funds for school projects. If you would

My particular focus as a governor is the 'SMSC' - spiritual, moral,


social and cultural – development aspects of school life, also the additional obligations for East Hoathly and St Mary's as Church Schools.

is native to the UK and is indeed nocturnal. The children were all given the opportunity to stroke Rusty and some even had a go at holding him, keeping their arm straight so as to mimic a branch. We absolutely loved our visit and the children were so excited to talk about the experience afterwards.
