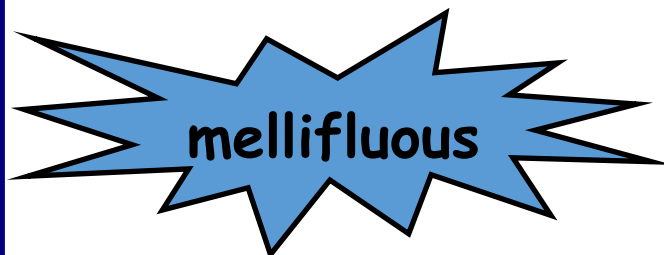

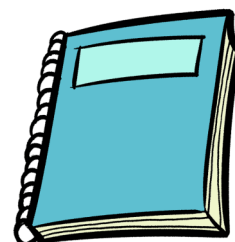
PFCS Request

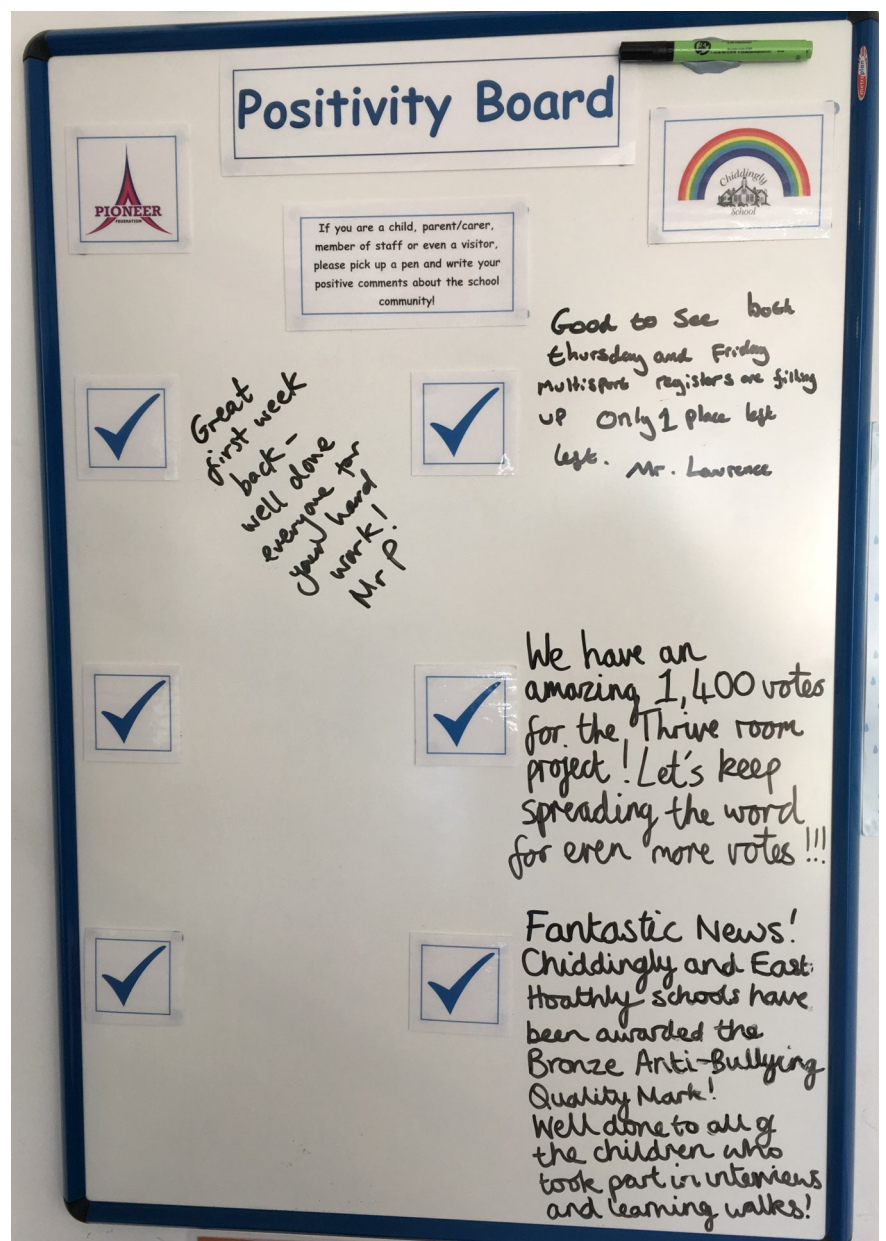


Positivity Board

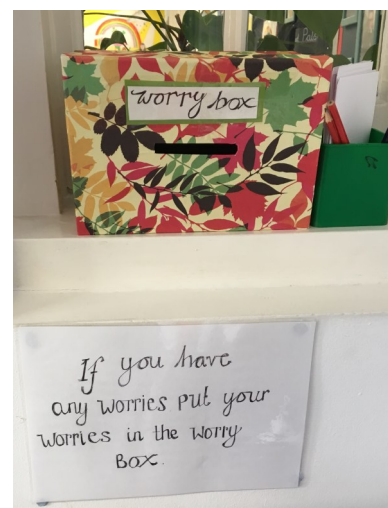


