They used excellent team work skills and their growth mindset by not giving up.

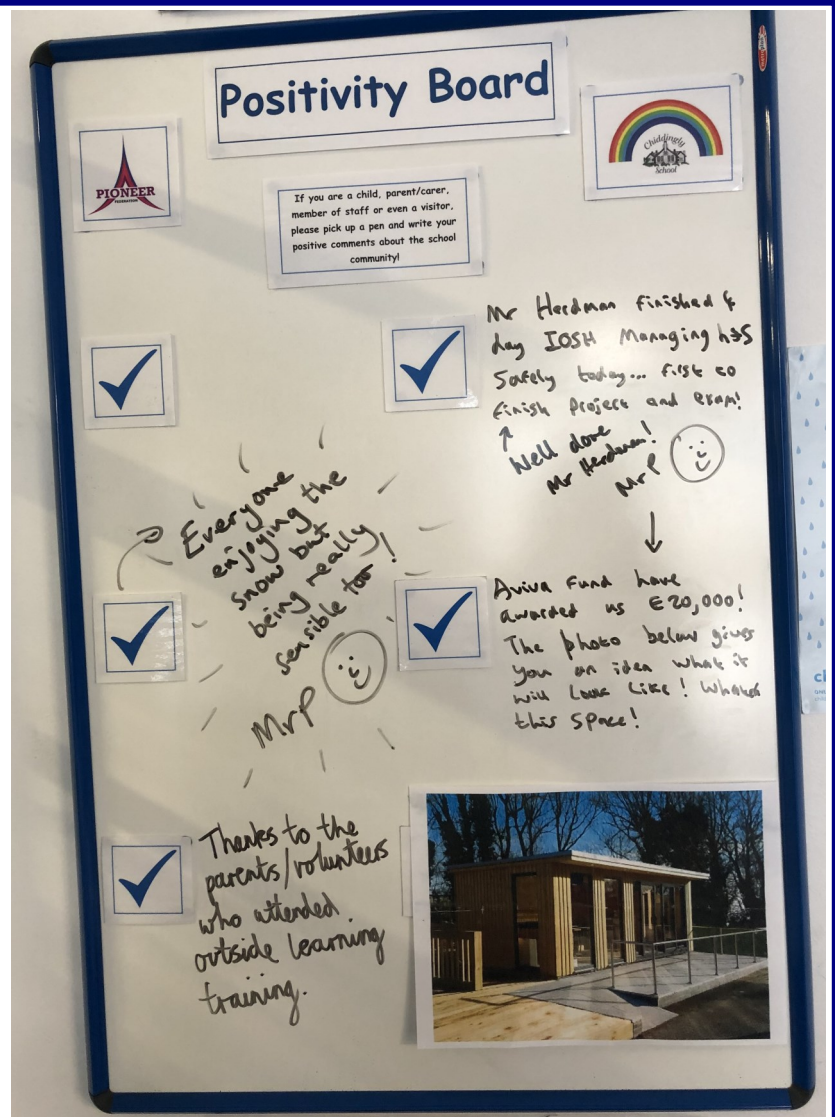


Positivity Board

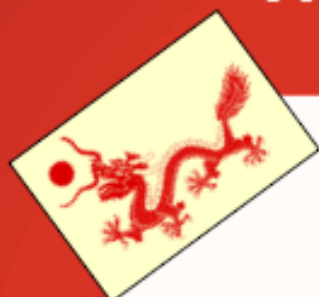
