


Positivity Board

CHIDDINGLY PRIMARY SCHOOL CHESS ACADEMY

The Academy is open to all children, whether established player or complete beginner.
The coaching sessions will be either before school or after school depending upon the preference.

Chess is fantastic to develop different mental skills including reasoning, logic, forward planning, and overlaps into other subject areas especially maths.

Throughout the year there will be a mix of coaching and playing sessions, with the aim of entering a
Chiddingly Primary Chess Academy team
in the
Delancey UK National Schools Chess Challenge

Our coaching follows the British Chess Institute syllabus , and leads to the award of the British Chess Institute
Certificates of Chess Excellence which are presented at the end of each term commencing with level 1.

The cost is £50 for the 10 chess sessions in the Summer term, starting during the week commencing on
the 29th April 2019

Places are limited to 20 children so contact the school office to book a provisional place
for your child.

You will be contacted before the end of the Spring term to make payment to confirm your
provisional place.
