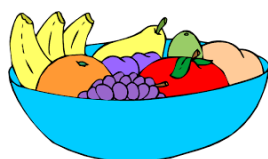

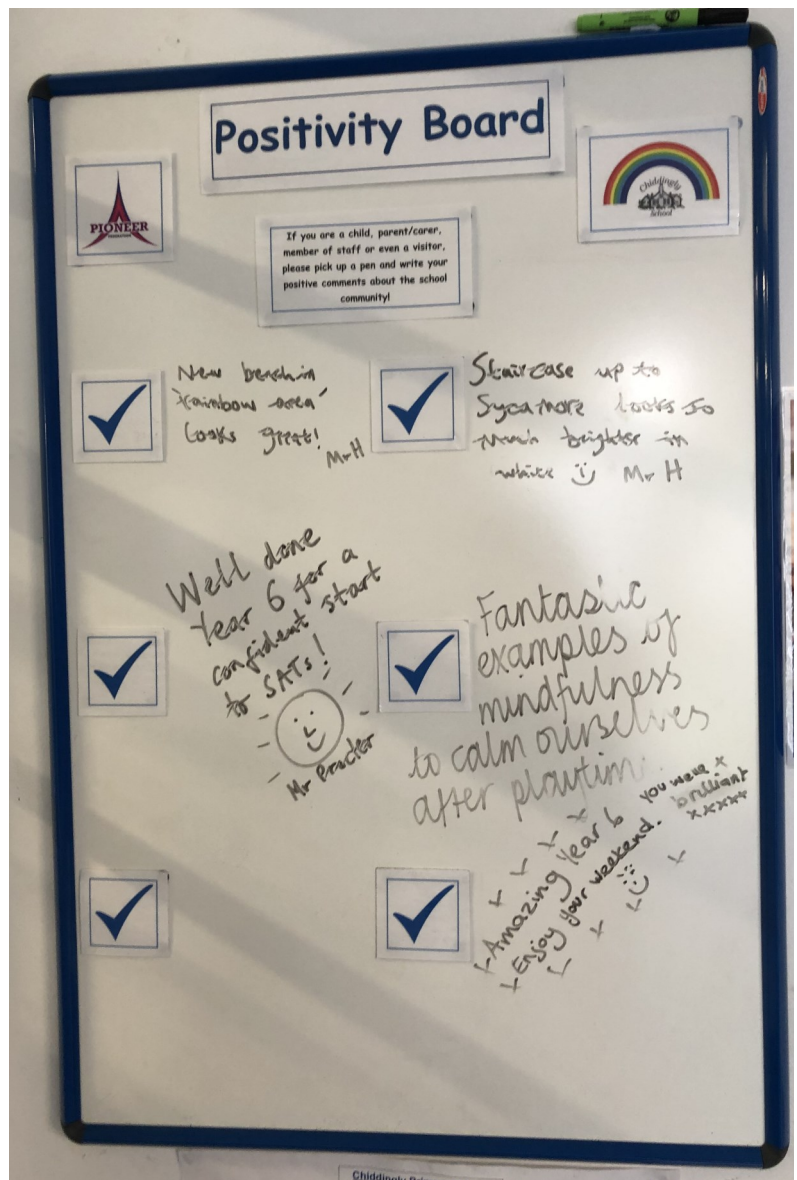

Parents and Friends of Chiddingly School (PFCS) play a crucial role in supporting Chiddingly Primary School.
