

PFCS News

I would like to say a massive Thank you to all of you parents, carers, grandparents and family members and friends for supporting the PFCS over the past two terms. With not being able to do our usual fundraising so far this school year we have found other ways. This includes Bags 2 School collection which raised £39.00, supporting the PFCS through amazon smile this term has raised £7.02, £29.53 for the past quarter from Easy Fundraising and altogether in 2020 £139.35. These alternative ways to help fundraise are much appreciated.

The PFCS have also raised £374.39 from the sale of Christmas items that had donated over the year. £265.00 from the Christmas Hamper Raffle and £385 profit from the sale of the School Tea Towels. 
