## Oak

Some of the children went on to explore more colours and what else they could make independently.

We have created our own aquarium with lots of unique fish that we designed ourselves. We wanted to show you how well the plants in our veg patch are doing. We also have plant pots with things like strawberries and tomatoes. You can buy some of our lettuce most days at the key stage 1 gate for 20p a bag. 














# Beech

















# Willow


