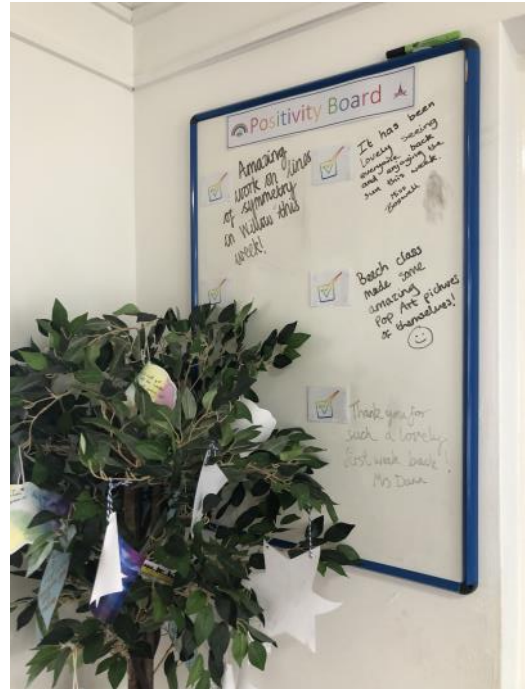
Welcome Back

Oak

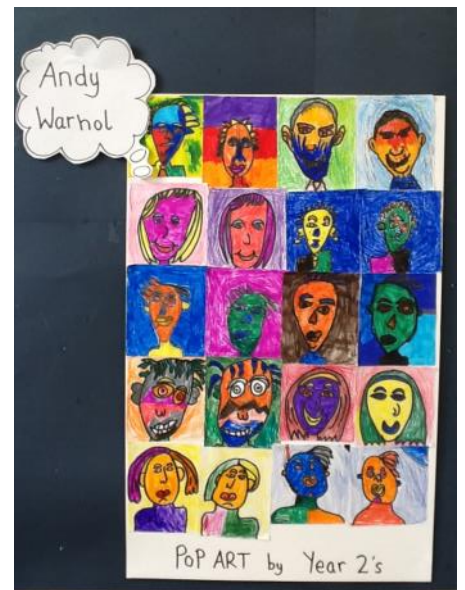
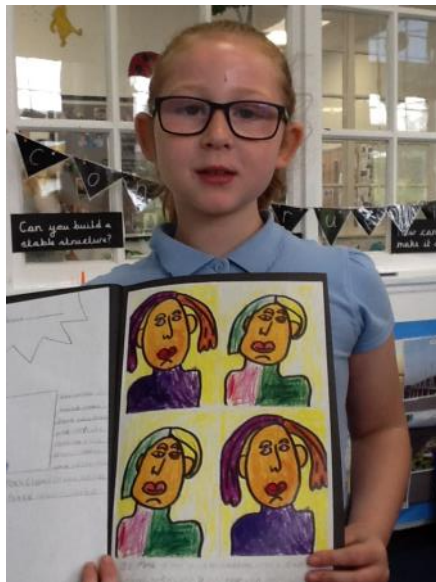
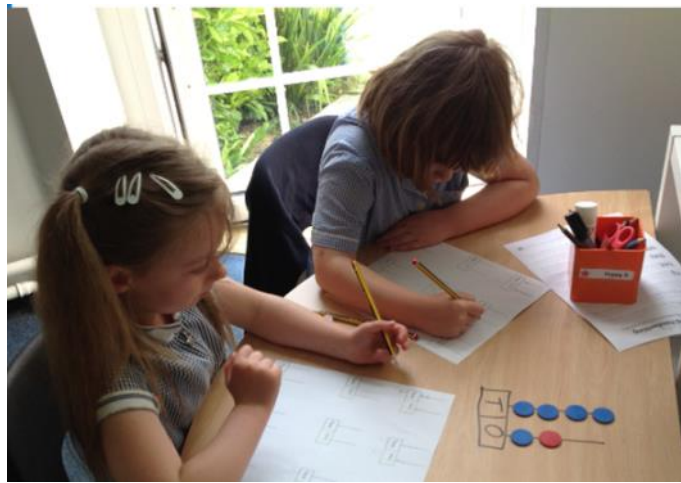
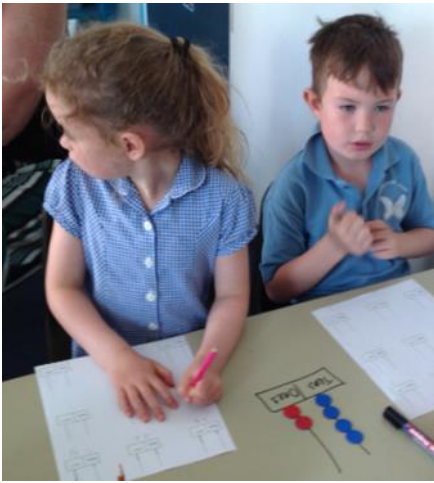
This week Oak class have been experimenting with colour and how to make new colours. They explored what colours they could make just using the primary colours. They had to add a drop of each colour into their petri dish and swirled the colours to see what they had made. They were then able to write up their findings. Some of the children went on to explore more colours and what else they could make independently.

We have created our own aquarium with lots of unique fish that we designed ourselves. We wanted to show you how well the plants in our veg patch are doing. We also have plant pots with things like strawberries and tomatoes. You can buy some of our lettuce most days at the key stage 1 gate for 20p a bag. We are hoping to raise enough money to buy a hose to help us with our watering. Keep an eye out for other veg and flowers coming soon (fingers crossed!)



Beech

This week in maths, we have been looking at Place value. We used only six counters to see how many different ways we could use them to make lots of numbers. We then thought about what the highest or lowest number we found was and if there were any patterns. We have also started our new topic about famous people, we learnt lots about famous astronauts and also about a famous artist called Andy Warhol. Look at the Pop Art pictures we drew of ourselves!

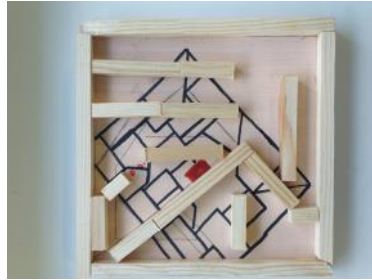
