Dear Chiddingly families,

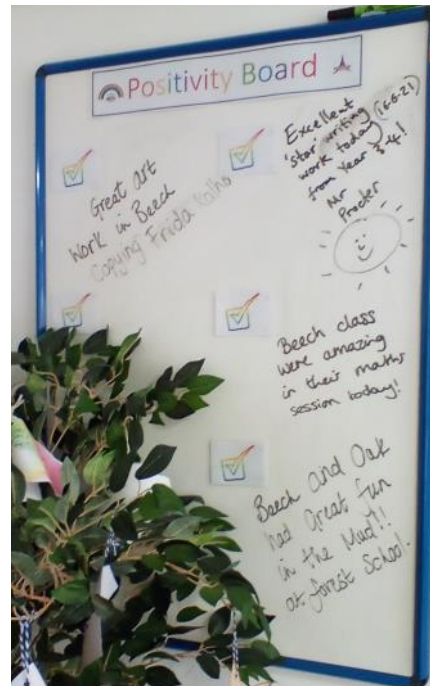

Our Learning Powers for next week are, Penelope and Frances in Oak, Joseph in Beech, Maxwell in Willow and Michael in Sycamore!



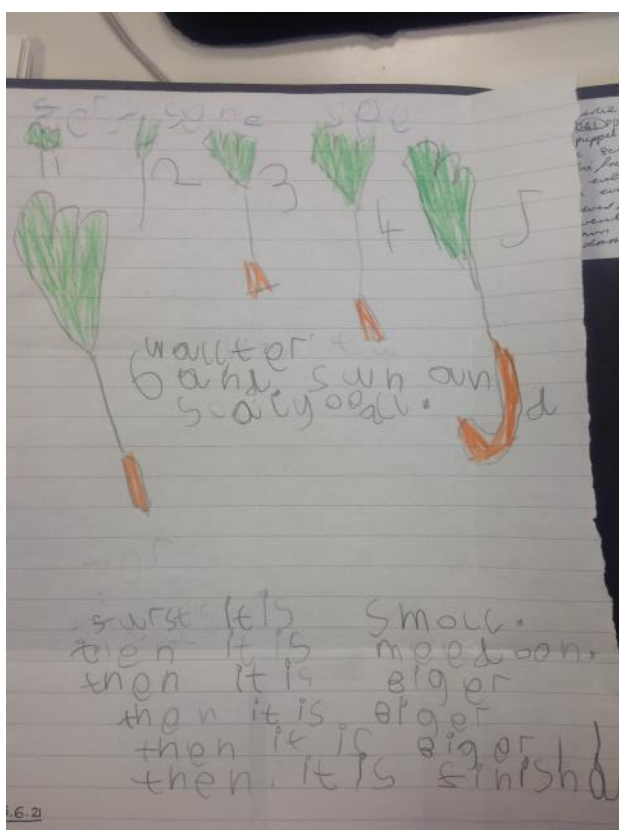
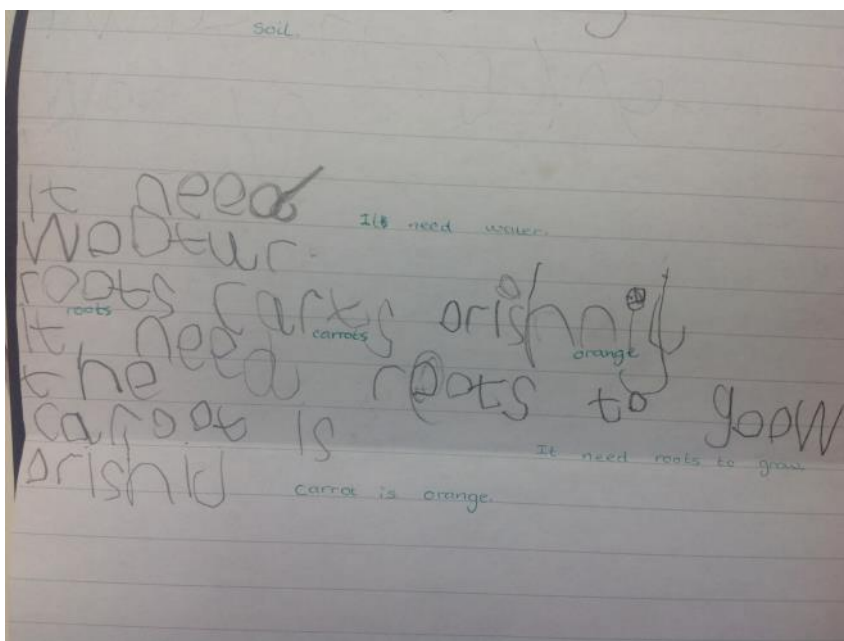

Oak

This week Oak class have been working super hard on their tricky trigraphs: ear, air and igh. We have also been writing stories using describing words like in 'The Snail and the Whale' (our story this week).

We have also really enjoyed being outside in the sun. We used magnifying glasses to see what our plants look like up close. We had a range of carrots all at different stages of growth and it was really cool to see how they change. Finley did some amazing writing about how to keep plants healthy and Bertie did some amazing work about how the carrots change.



Beech

We have been learning about another famous person, this time it was Frida Kahlo! We even had a visit from 'Frida' to ask her about her life (shhh don't tell Miss B we worked out it was her!) We then used her art to inspire our own portraits!



Willow

The children in Willow Class have enjoyed making Ancient Greek pots out of clay this week. They learnt why they were so useful and important to historians and to archaeologists to find out how the ancient Greeks lived. They learnt 2 methods of making clay pots and chose which they preferred in making their own. They are painting them next, using traditional Greek patterns.

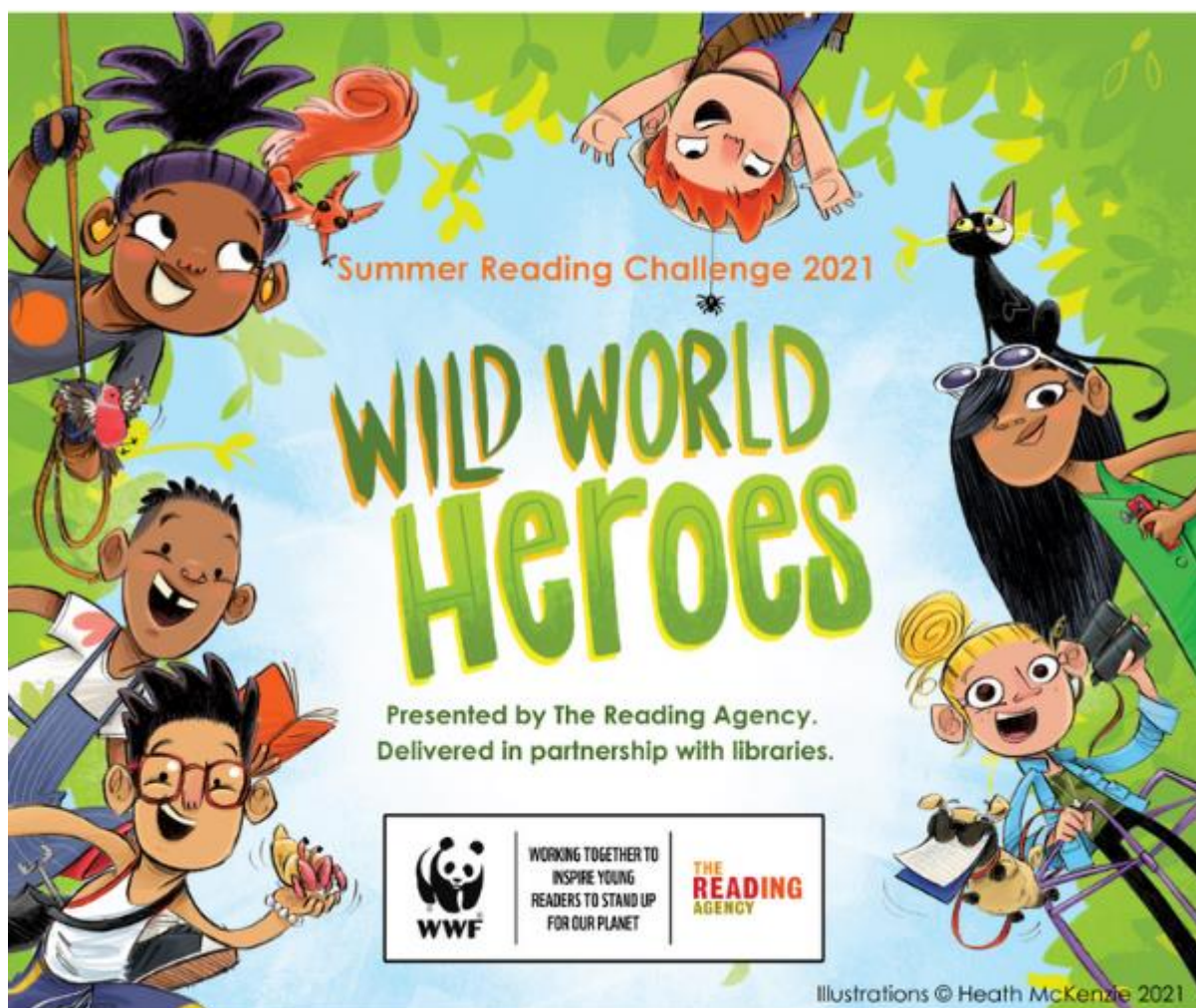
