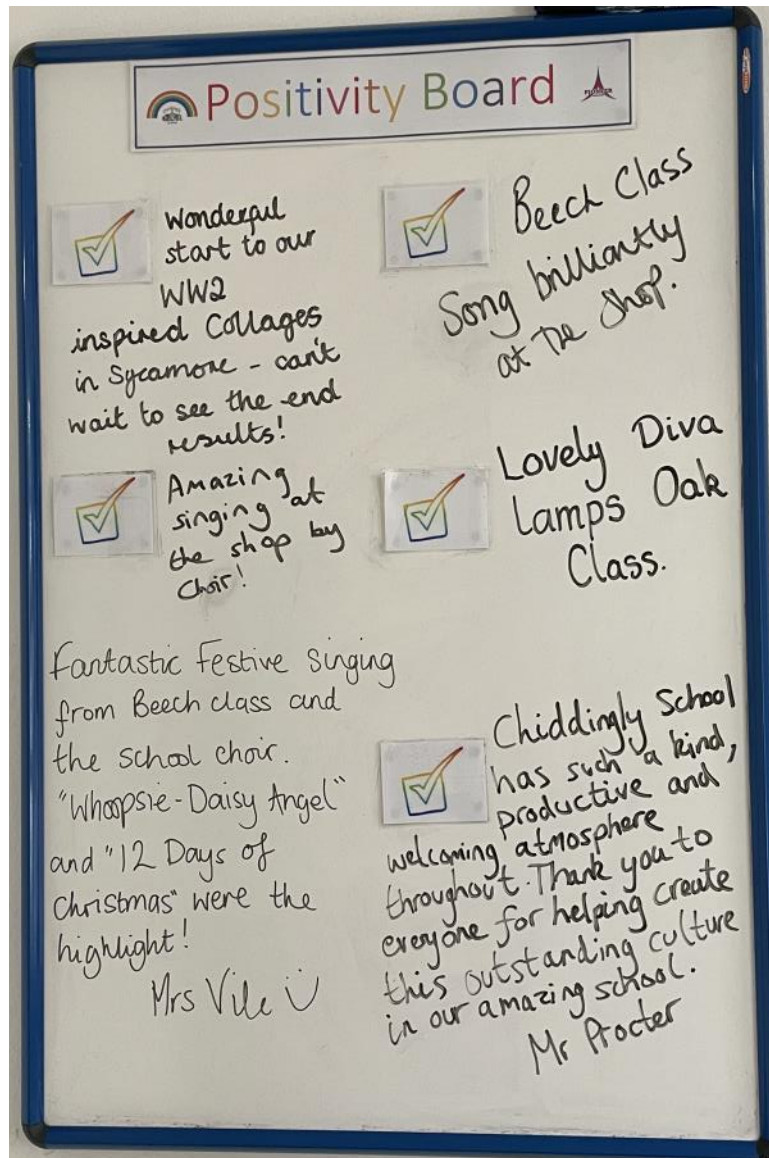

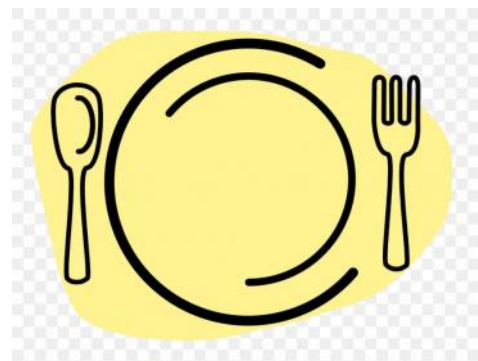

## Class Updates

### Oak

## Sycamore

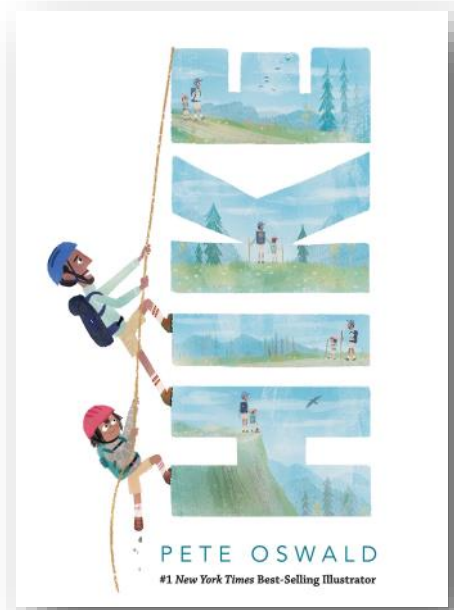
