
Reception Newsletter Term 1 2021


Dear Parents,

Firstly, we would like to say how impressed we have been with the children since they have started with us. They have all settled into school life amazingly!

Our topic for this first term is 'Amazing Me'. Alongside this, we will be working on counting, number recognition, and recognising amounts. We will also be developing our foundation understanding of letters and sounds.

We will be exploring stories such a 'Farmer Duck', 'Rosie's Walk', 'Little Red Hen' and The Naughty Bus, alongside the children's favourite books.





The attached learning map will expand on how each area of learning will be linked to the stories.

Home Learning

We encourage children to continue their learning at home which will enhance their progress at school. Reading at home is key to your children's success. We ask that every child reads at home at least 3 times a week.

There will be a meeting in the coming weeks, to discuss home learning, reading and phonics. We will send out further information about this closer to the time.

As the year progresses and children's understanding develops, home learning tasks will adapt and increase appropriately.

Reading:

<u>Please read with your child regularly</u>. At this stage it is really helpful to encourage the children to use the pictures to tell stories.

We change the children's home reading books regularly and read 1:1 with each child in school. Therefore, their books and book bags will be needed in school every day. You may like to add a positive or helpful comment in the reading diary but please acknowledge that the book has been read by signing and dating in the comments section.

More information about our reading strategies will be shared at the meeting.

<u>Maths:</u> We will be using CBeebies Number Blocks to help with our teaching of number. We will be starting with '1' and then taking a different number every week to understand the value and embed foundations. Other maths activities will be taking place at the same time.

This is part of the recommendations from the Maths Mastery approach.



Quick Reminders

- Please can you make sure your child brings in a water bottle and their book bag each day.
- Can the children please always bring a **coat** particularly as the British weather is unpredictable.
- Our regular PE days are Wednesday but **PE** kits should be in all week as we fit in other sessions where possible. We will send the PE kits home as needed.
