



Dear Parents,

This term we will be starting our new topic of 'Bright Lights, Big City'. We will begin the term looking at countries and cities in the UK and then begin to spread our wings further afield, looking at other parts of the world.

Some of the key texts we will be using for our learning are:







Questions to ask at home:

Have you been to any cities? What are they like?

How are cities different to the towns and villages that we live in?

What is the difference between a country and a continent?

What things give us light?

Which body parts can you name?

Can you identify which senses you are using in different situations?

How do wheels work?

Also remember those key discussion points around key dates such as bonfire night and Remembrance Day.

Home Learning Tasks

Please have a go at some of these at home:

- Make a model of a city landmark using junk modelling, construction kits, lego, blocks etc. and take a photo of it to share or bring it in for show and tell!
- Find out about some of the continents, countries and capital cities in the world. Maybe you have photographs of your holidays the children could share.

Home Learning

Reading	Please read with your child at least three times a week , even if it is just for 5 minutes. Please ensure their reading journal is written in so we can add it to our total on a Friday morning to hopefully win the class prize that week! We are continuing with our reading scheme, Little Wandle, so the children will have lots of opportunity to read in class but topping this up at home is essential to learning. During reading sessions, please discuss the story with your child and ask them questions about what they are reading. These questions will help to develop their understanding of what they are reading as comprehension and discussion are key reading skills in Year 1 and 2. Library books will be changed on a Friday.
Spellings	Children in year 1 will be sent home with a phonics homework sheet on a Monday
and	which will share the sounds, sentences and spelling we will have covered during the
phonics	previous week. The children can share their learning with you. There isn't a formal
	spelling test in Year 1, however there will always be 5 words at the bottom of the
	sheet that they have learnt in school that week and it would be great to practise these
Phonics/	at home too! Their phonics and spellings all fit in with the new reading scheme. Children in Year 2 will be sent home with spellings based on the spelling curriculum
spelling	rules they will have been taught during the week on a Monday , they will be tested
Year 2	on these on the following Monday . To begin with they recap the alternative spelling
	patterns for the sounds they learnt in year one, then they move on to rules within
	spellings.
_	Please can children continue to learn their times tables at home.
Maths	Year 1 children should be learning 10x, 2x and 5x tables.
	When secure with the 2x, 5x and 10x tables, Year 2 children should be moving onto
	3x and 4x tables.
