Class Updates

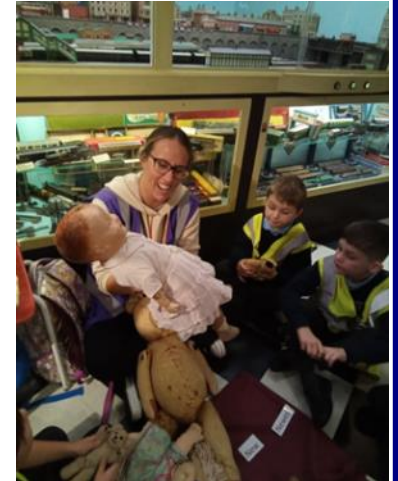
Oak

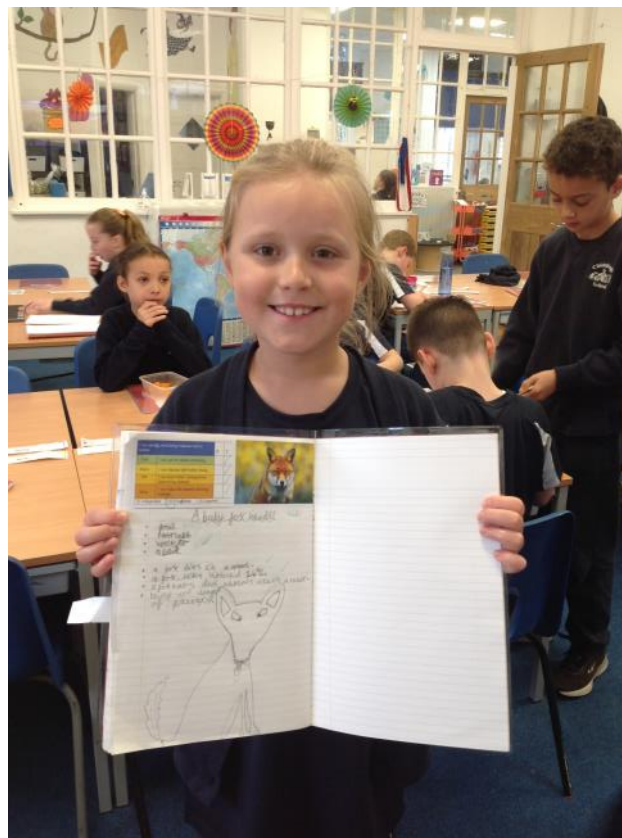
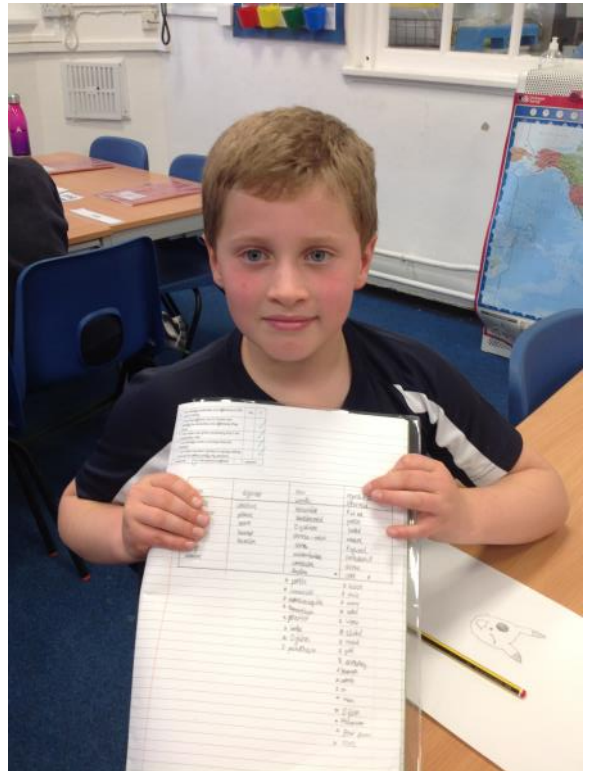
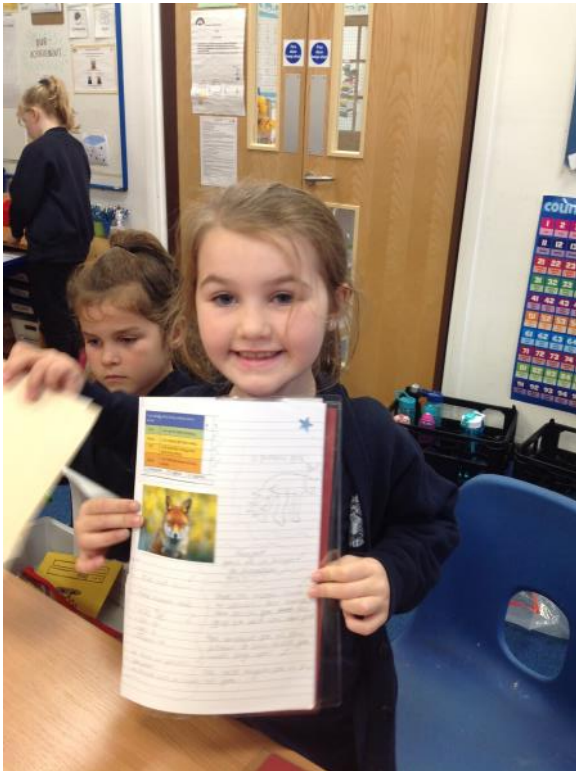
Beech

Beech class went to the Toy Museum last term and had a great time learning about toys in the past. They were so grateful to have this opportunity which was funded by a local charity.



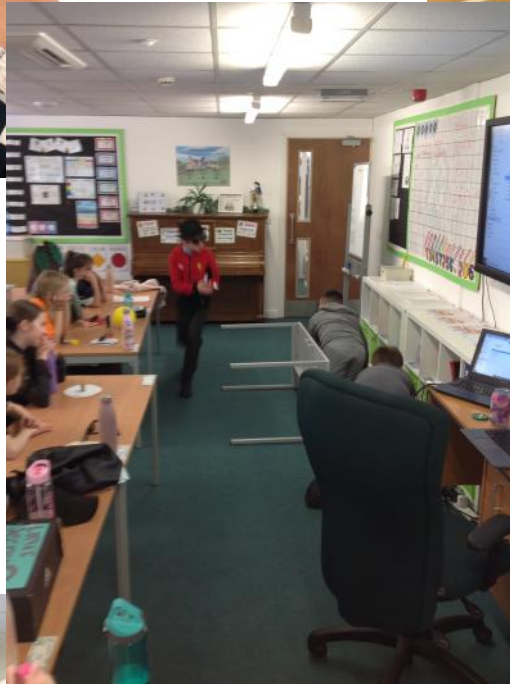
Willow

Village Shop Artwork

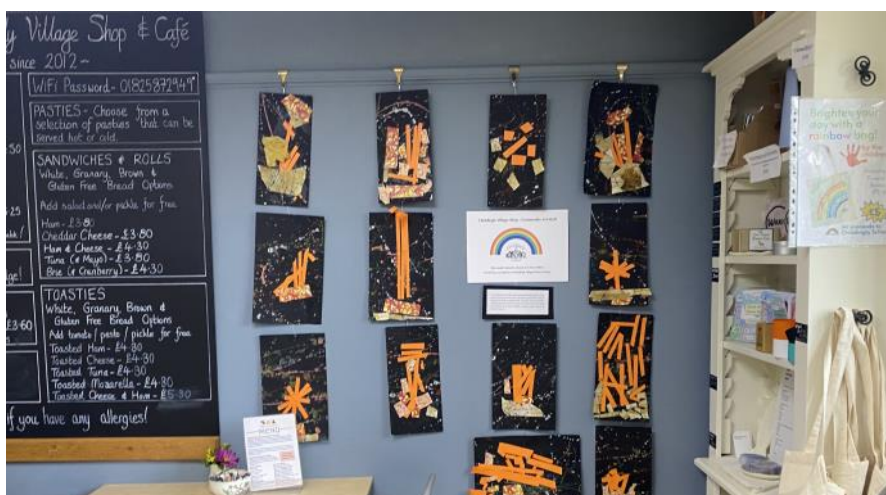
Chiddingly Village Shop & Cafe are proudly displaying paintings by Oak Class this month, on their community art wall

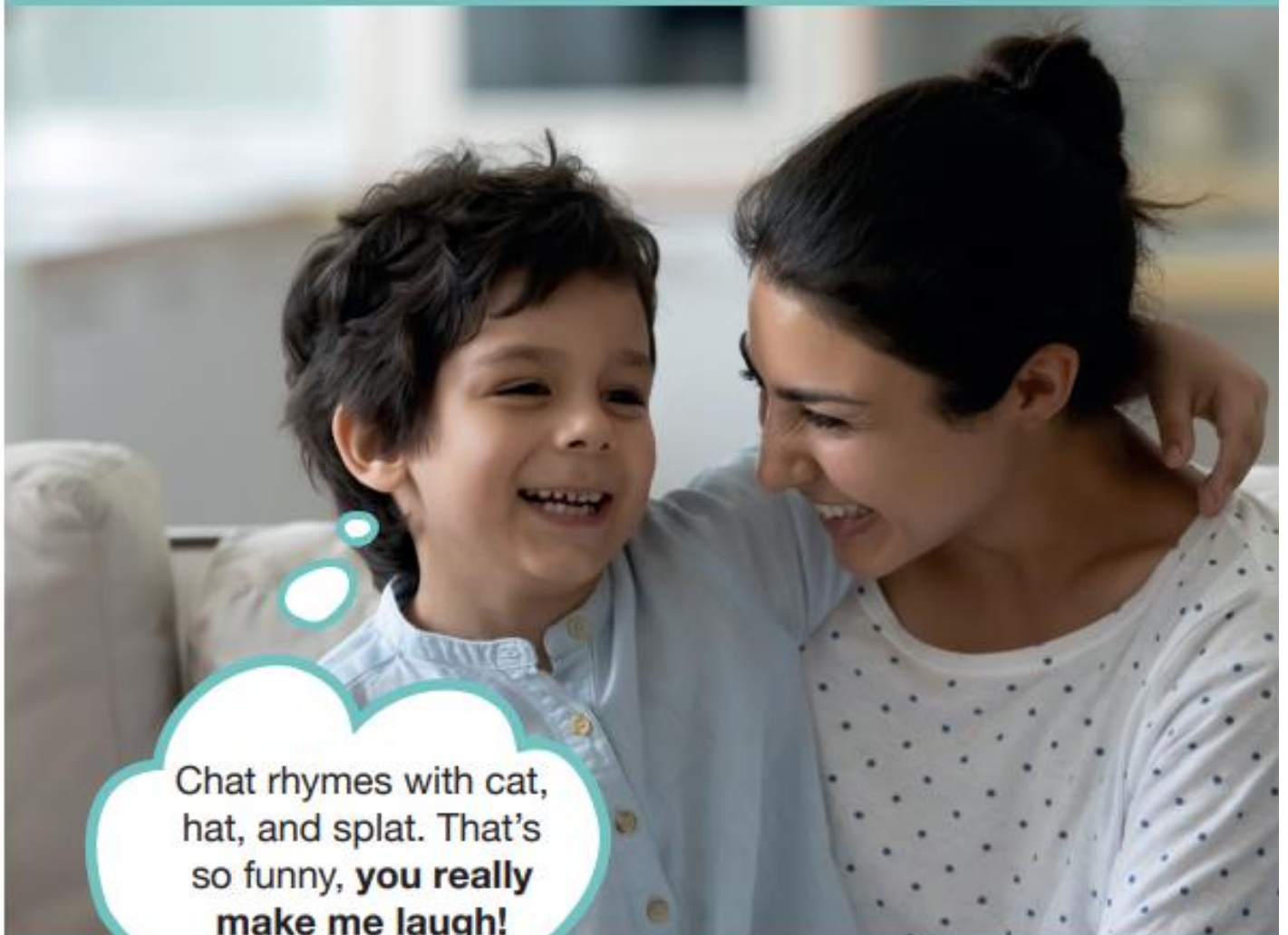
