



# Term 4 Newsletter

Dear Parents,

Our topic for Term 4 will be, **'Amazon Adventures'**. We will be travelling to South America to explore this fascinating ecosystem. Throughout our journey we will be discovering the animals that live there, the four layers that make up the rainforest and finding out about a variety of plants; even ones that can grow without soil! We will be using the texts 'The Great Kapok Tree' and 'The Vanishing Forest' to support our learning.

<b>Reading</b>	Please read with your child at least three times a week at home and ensure that their reading record is signed and dated. A member of staff will be checking reading diaries on a Friday.
<b>Spellings</b>	Spelling tests are every Friday, and your child will be tested on the spelling pattern they have learnt that week. New spellings will be sent out every Friday, along with their homework.
<b>Maths &amp; English</b>	Maths and English homework will be set on a Friday and will be expected to have been completed in a fortnight. Maths and English homework will be set in their CGP homework books, the relevant pages will be outlined on their homework sheet.
<b>Times Tables</b>	Each child will have a Times Table Rockstars login and should be practising their tables (either on this website or in another way) three times a week at home.

### Questions you could ask your child about their learning this term:








- Where is the Amazon Rainforest?
