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| Spellings | Spelling tests are every Friday, and your child will be tested on the spelling pattern they have learnt about that week. New spellings will be sent out every Monday. |
| Maths | Maths homework will be set on a Monday and will be expected to have been completed by the Friday of that week. Maths homework will be set on a sheet photocopied for the children. |
| Times Tables | Each child has a Times Table Rockstars login and should be practising their tables (either on this website or in another way) three times a week at home. |
| Grammar | Grammar homework will be sent home on a Monday and your child will have two weeks to complete this, due in on the Friday. |
