Dear Parents.

For our final term we will be continuing in the exploration of Ancient Greece. We will be developing our learning into the Olympics, finding out what sports took place. We will then be learning about the battle of Troy and how they used the ingenious trick for the Trojan Horse. In our DT we will be learning to make clay pots just like the Cretians did.

Reading	Please read with your child at least three times a week at home and ensure that their reading record is signed and dated. A member of staff will be checking reading diaries on a Friday.			
Spellings	Spelling tests are every Friday, and your child will be tested on the spelling pattern they have learnt that week. New spellings will be sent out every fortnight.			
Maths	Maths homework will be set on a Friday and will be expected to have been completed within the fortnight. Maths homework will consist of specific pages in the CPG books, and a multiplication sheet attached to their homework sheet.			
Times Tables	Each child will have a Times Table Rockstars login and should be practising their tables (either on this website or in another way) three times a week at home.
