P	honics	The children will bring home a weekly phonics sheet on a Friday showing all the phonics they have learnt that week. This will form part of their weekly reading. Please record on Boom reader when your child has read these at home.
N	Maths	We are excited to start a new online maths homework called 'Mathletics' more information will follow at the start of the new term. Year 2 will also be practising their 2, 5, and 10 times tables so it would be great if you could reinforce these with your child. Mathletics will be set on a Monday. To be completed by the following Sunday.


Useful information and reminders:


- Please make sure you name everything that comes into school.
