We will be developing our understanding of biography writing, poetry and description writing. We will be using a variety of texts to support our learning including Darwin's Dragons, Charles Darwin's 'On the Origin of Species' by Anna Brett and Amazing Evolution.

Reading.	Please read with your child at least three times a week at home and ensure that you record this using the Boom Reader app. All children in the class have a Lexia account and will be able to log-on to this at home to complete tasks. Your child may wish to do this instead of reading so please record any Lexia sessions using the Boom Reader app also. A member of staff will be checking app entries on a Friday.
