

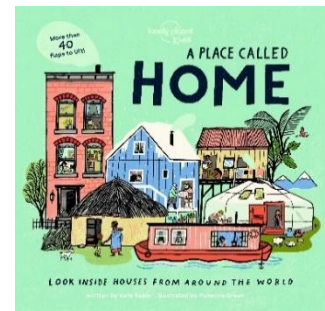
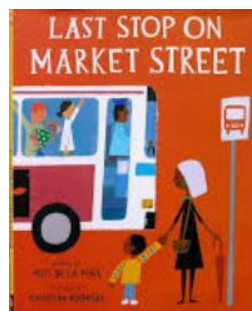
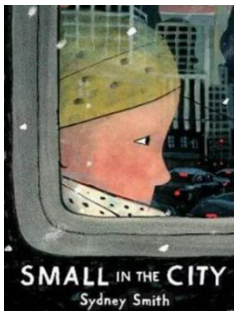
Home and Away Newsletter Term 3 2025

What is the difference between a country and a continent?




















What is the weather like today?

Home Learning

Reading	Please read with your child at least three times a week , even if it is just for 5 minutes. When reading with your child, please acknowledge you have read by <u>recording this on Boom Reader.</u> During reading sessions, please discuss the story with your child and ask them questions about what they are reading. These questions will help to develop their understanding of what they are reading. They will come home with a new reading book every Friday and can also bring a library book home if they wish!
Phonics Year 1	Each week a phonics home learning sheet will come home. This will show you the learning we will be covering in the week. Your child could read this as part of their weekly reading.
Maths	Maths homework will be set via <i>Mathletics</i> on a Monday to complete within the week. If you would like paper copies of the homework please ask.
Spelling patterns in school	Our spelling focuses this term will be: Adding the suffixes '-ing' and '-ed' Words where the digraph 'ie' makes an /ee/ sound Words with the digraphs 'ay' and 'oy' Words with the digraphs 'ph' and 'wh' We learn these at school and will be sharing these with you each term if you would like to reinforce these patterns with your child at home.
