Subject: French

Key Concept/ Theme: Je fais du sport - being able to name French sports and being able to say what you play/ do or do not play/ do

Prior Learning links: Children have previously covered some of these within the topic Hobbies in Year 3 and 4. They have also previously covered clothing so will be able to describe the different clothes worn for different sporting activities

Vocabulary:

je fais du sport, le tennis, le skate, le foot, le basket, le vélo, la natation, la pétanque, la danse, jouer, faire, Je ne joue pas, Je joue, Je fais, Je ne fais pas, J'adore... J'aime, Je n'aime pas, Je déteste, et mais aussi, il neige, il pleut, vent, Quand, chaud, froid, fait, fais, porte, une joupe, un patalon, des tennis, des chaussers, des chausettes, un maillot de bain, un tee-shirt, des chaussures de danse, des chaussures de foot

- **Reconnection:** True or false guiz reviewing le/la, masculine/feminine, what is a verb
 - LO: Let's name different sports in French saying different sports

 - masculine and feminine nouns
 - definite articles (le, la)

Activity: variety of listening and writing (and spelling and reading if class teacher deems them appropriate) activities (as in resources) to embed new knowledge

- **Reconnection:** True or False quiz review of which words means to play/ to do and to be able to name some sports in French
 - LO: Let's use 'I play' or 'I don't play' and 'I do' or 'I don't do' sports in French
 - saying which sports you play and do or don't play or do
 - à + definite articles (au, à la)
 - de + definite article (du, de la)
 - conjugation regular verbs (-ER): je joue, je ne joue pas
 - faire (je fais, je ne fais pas de)

Activity: variety of listening and writing (and spelling and reading if class teacher deems them appropriate) activities (as in resources) to embed new knowledge

- Reconnection: True or False quiz recapping je joue, je ne joue pas/ je fais, je ne fais pas de
- LO: Let's give opinions on sports in French
 - giving opinions of different sports and joining opinions using conjunctions
 - definite articles (le, la)
 - conjugation regular verbs (-ER): j'aime, je n'aime pas, j'adore, je déteste
 - conjunctions (et, aussi, mais)
 - notion of infinitives (jouer, faire)

Activity: variety of listening and writing (and spelling and reading if class teacher deems them appropriate) activities (as in resources) to embed new knowledge

- Children will be able to explain the clothes that they wear for different sporting activities
- Children will be able to say what sports they are able to play/do in different weathers.
