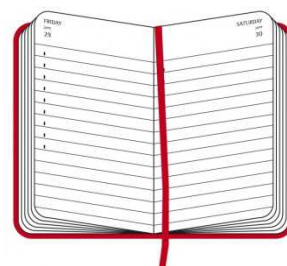

## SKiL CIC Clubs at East Hoathly School November-December 2015

Dear Parent or Carer,

### Changes to Clubs

In order to deliver and offer a wider range of activities we have decided to merge our clubs with East Hoathly. Due to resources available at Chiddingly, increased numbers at both sites and parent feedback, we will be running 2 activities which will run alongside each other. Thus giving children more choice and options. It will also allow SKiL to provide a better quality service due to having more staff members available.

### After School Clubs

These sessions will start from Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2015 and will be on every Tuesday and Wednesday until the week beginning 14th December. These clubs will go ahead whatever the weather. In extreme circumstances for safety reasons, we will use a classroom to look at other aspects of activity, such as health, or play indoor games. If the school is closed or has an event on we will do our utmost to continue the session. However, if we are unable to do this we will notify parents and carers with as much notice as possible that the session is cancelled. The session that has been missed and paid for will then be carried over to the next half term or if this cannot be done a refund will be provided for the session.

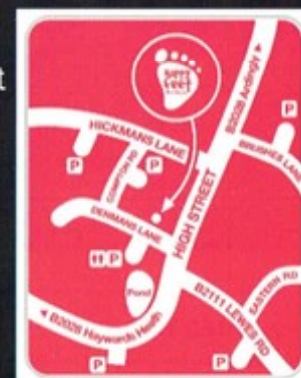
