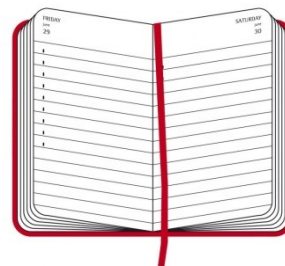

Breakfast and After School Club

As you are aware, we opened up a Breakfast (Early Birds) and After School Club (Late Birds) last term.

Impetigo
