
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

#### Enterprise Week 15<sup>th</sup> - 19<sup>th</sup> May 2017

The week beginning Monday  $15^{\text{th}}$  May 2017 will be our **Enterprise Week**. Each class will be given a budget of £20.00. They will then use this to buy resources to make ladybird themed products to sell at the end of the week.

This is because we are supporting the Mayor of Lewes' charity Pestalozzi. You can find out more about this charity at <u>http://www.pestalozzi.org.uk/</u>. Their mission is to produce globally conscious young leaders by supporting their further education in the multi-cultural, multi-faith environment of the Pestalozzi International Community. On Friday 19<sup>th</sup> May there will be a Celebration Assembly at 9:15am where we will do the normal celebrations alongside a celebration of our learning during the week. All are welcome to join us for this.
