We would like to remind you of the structure of leadership at East Hoathly School and Nursery.

Executive Head - Mr James Procter.

Mr Procter leads the Pioneer Federation of East Hoathly and Chiddingly, and from September took on St Mary's, Hartfield. He spends 1.5-2 days per week in school but is contactable at the other schools when not on site.

Deputy Head – **Miss Vicky Lewis**. Miss Lewis is the Deputy Head for the Pioneer Federation of East Hoathly and Chiddingly. She spends 50% of the week at East Hoathly but is contactable at Chiddingly when not on site.

Senior Teacher – Miss Lisa Purcell. Miss Purcell is the Senior Teacher for East Hoathly Primary School. She teaches Year 5 and 6 alongside her other responsibilities.

EYFS Leader - Miss Sheridan Denney. Miss Denney leads the EYFS team at East Hoathly School and Nursery and teaches Reception class alongside her other responsibilities.

One or more members of the School Leadership Team (SLT) are always on site and out of class, leading the school. When teachers are out of class, cover is provided by staff established within the federation.

Nut Allergies


Just a gentle reminder that East Hoathly is a nut free school.


