Please be aware that from the 1st of March 2018, the school will be unable to accept the old style £10 notes.

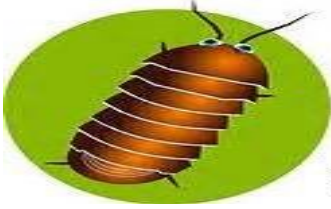

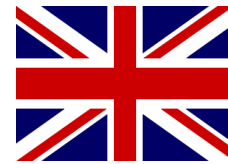

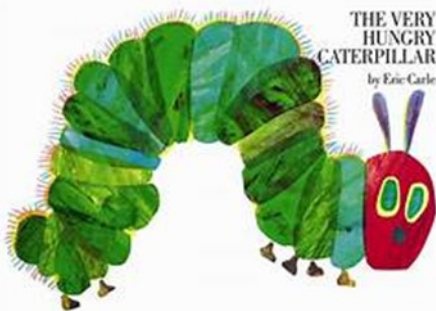


## Nursery News

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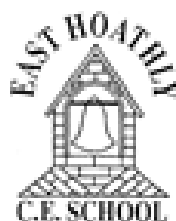
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
