



Pre- school Ballet Classes



for children aged 3 years and up in East Hoathly

Due to popular demand, Royal Ballet School trained teacher and Imperial society of Teachers of Dancing ballet Examiner Fleur Jones is opening up her ballet classes in East Hoathly and Halland to children from 3yrs from September 2018. Fleur has been teaching for over 25yrs and has taught extensively including Royal Ballet School Junior Associates, as well as owning her own full time theatre school. Past pupils of Fleur's are currently appearing in shows in the West End and have danced with ballet companies around the world, including with the Royal Ballet.

Classes are held on Wednesday in term and will be at The Village Hall at East Hoathly from Spring Term 2018. One to one lessons for children of any age can also be accommodated by arrangement.

The classes have been going for 2 years now and the ballet school, called Milestones School of Ballet, has flourished, bringing a healthy mix of fun, exercise and artistic development to the children of East Hoathly and Halland. Last year the pupils had a fantastic time performing on stage and more opportunities are afoot!

This week, Fleur will be teaching a morning of workshops for the children of East Hoathly Primary School to coincide with their activities for Sports Relief. Classes will also include preschool and nursery children, to help introduce youngsters to alternative forms of exercise and expression.

Fleur's vision is to create and nurture a love of dance inside each child and to help them express themselves through the art of Classical ballet. She is keen to continue developing the ballet classes in the heart of the local community and to this end is opening up the opportunity for younger children to attend. As of September 2018, she is starting a preschool class and is taking names for a waiting list for classes for 3yr to 4yr olds for this.

Fleur is a Graduate of the Royal Ballet School Teacher's Training Course and holds the Fellowship (highest qualification) of the Imperial Society of Teacher's of Dancing in Imperial Ballet.

Fleur was the Rochester - upon - Medway 'Talent Trust' winner in 1989, winner of the ISTD Mavdor Scholarship in 1998 and gained her Master of Arts Degree in Ballet Studies from University of Surrey, Roehampton, in 2007. She has been a Children's and Vocational Examiner for the Imperial Society of Teachers of Dancing (ISTD - Imperial Ballet) since 2004 and also teaches freelance and is qualified to teach both ISTD and Royal Academy of Dance syllabi. She also holds the Certificate in Dance Education and is DBS checked.

Classes are held on Wednesday afternoons at The Village Hall, East Hoathly and start from just £4.00 a class.
