







Measles

There has been a significant measles outbreak across Surrey and East Sussex.

By the age of 5, children should have received 2 doses of MMR. If children are not fully vaccinated, it is never too late to get them immunised. There is no upper age limit to offering MMR.

If you feel your child is presenting symptoms of measles, please consult a doctor and inform the school of the outcome.


The whole school attendance for this year so far is: 94.5%
