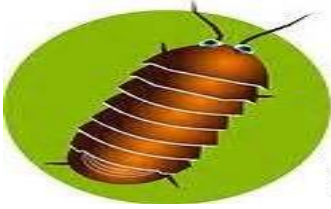

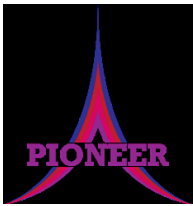

We welcome volunteers to help with readers, forest school, swimming and some school trips.



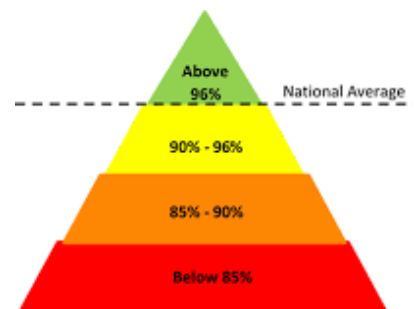
## Attendance

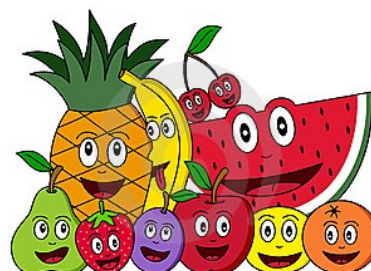
