Please come along, bring a blanket and a picnic. Everyone is welcome!

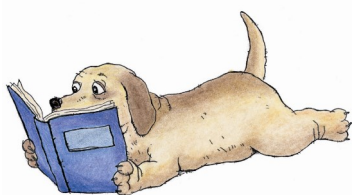

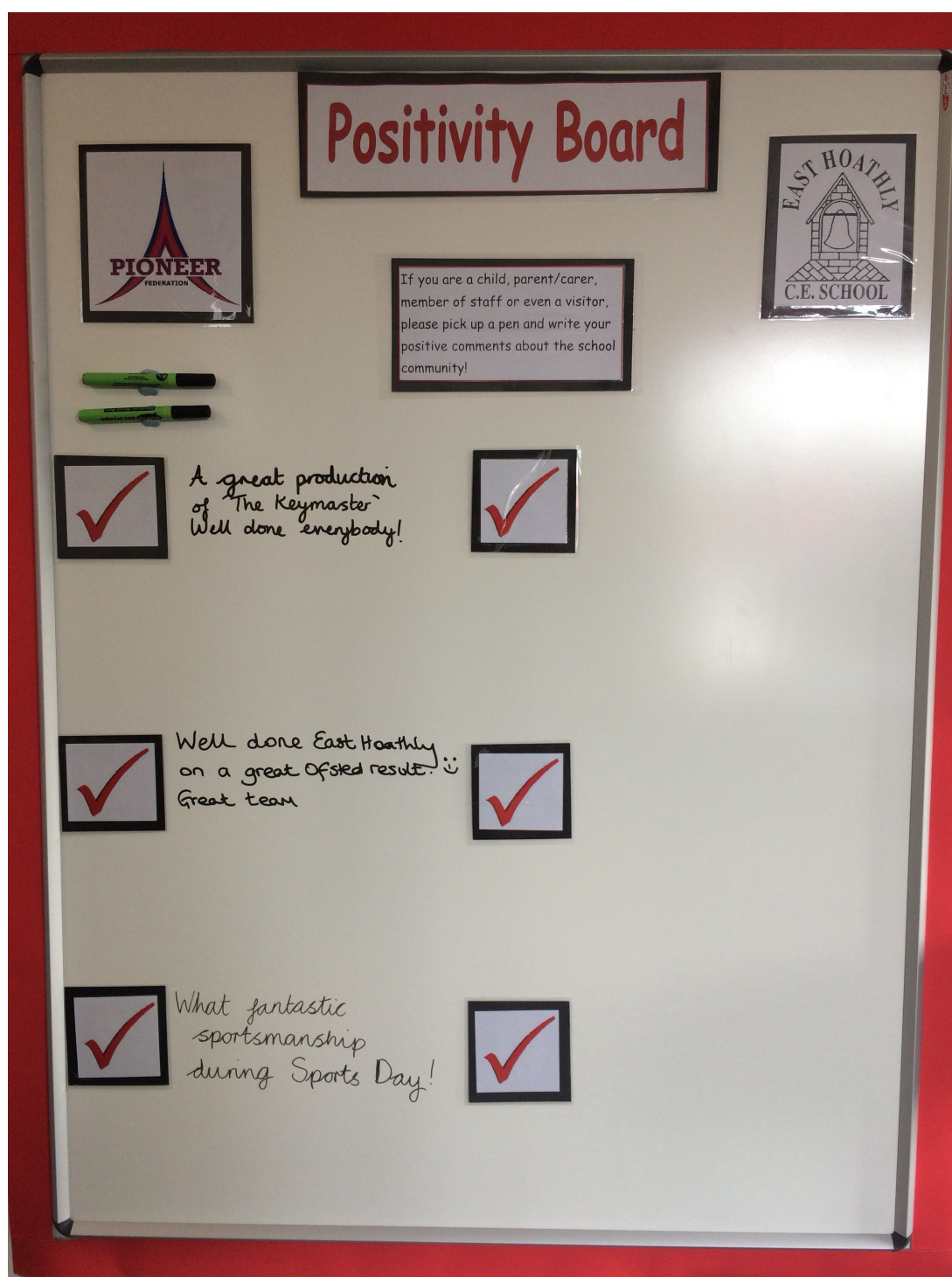


Positivity Board

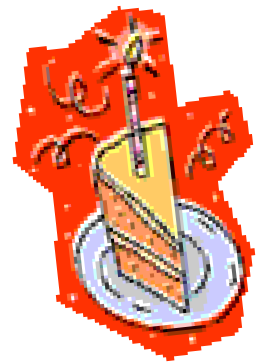

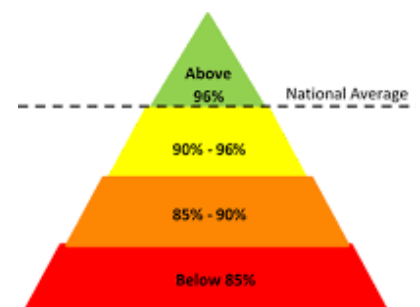
Attendance

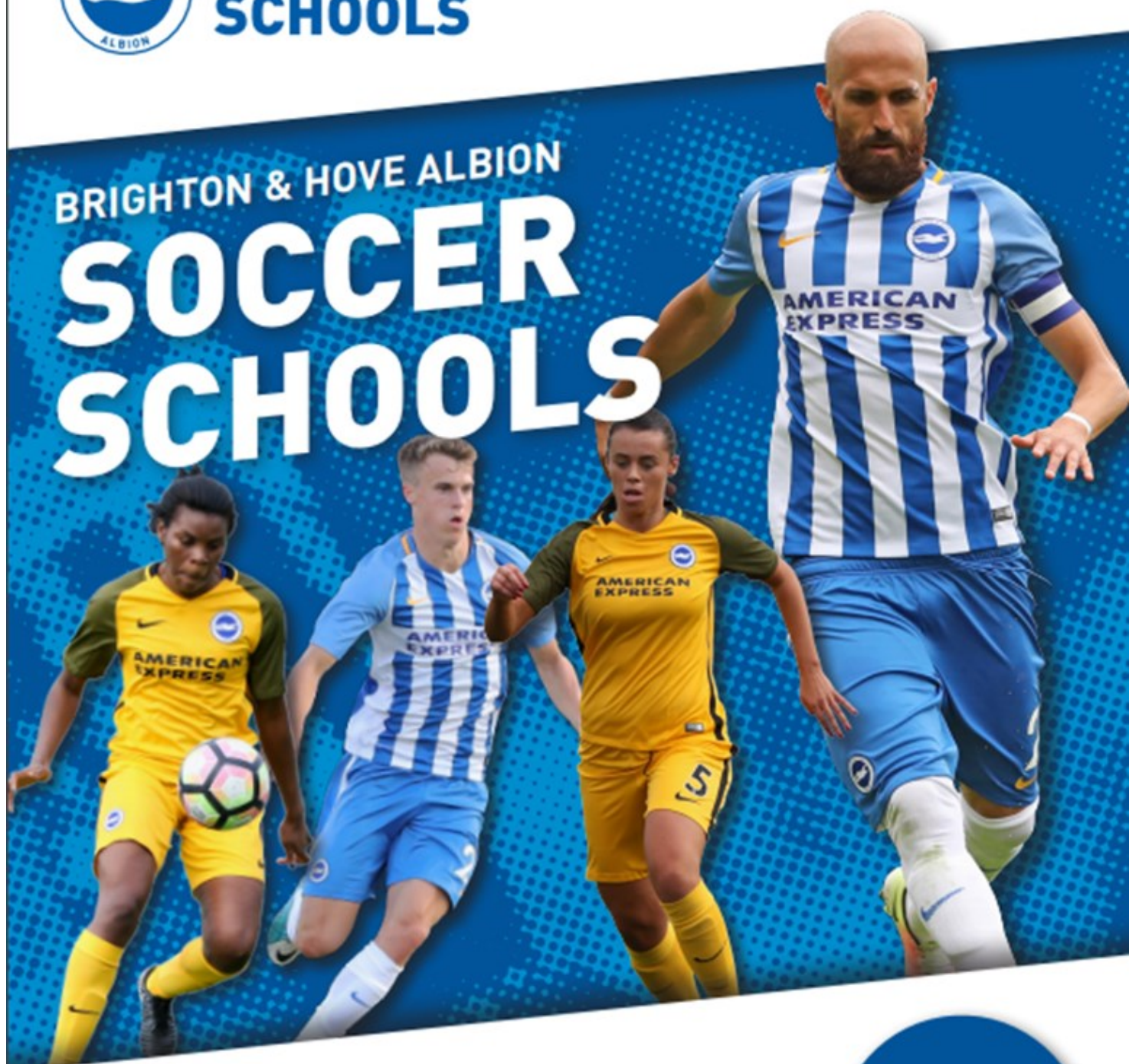
