# **Uniform Policy**

For Term 1, children can wear either Summer or Winter uniform. Just to remind you, here is the list for each set of uniform.

# School sweatshirt/cardigan with the school logo, white polo shirt with school logo or plain white polo shirt, grey trousers, skirt, pinafore dress, shorts or red and white striped (or checked) dress, white, grey or black socks, and black school shoes that cover the child's toes. Hairbands - should be plain. Scrunchies or ribbons should be black, white or red (non-decorative).

Winter

KS1: School sweatshirt/cardigan/jumper with the school logo, white polo shirt with school logo or plain white polo shirt or white shirt with a school tie (elasticated ties are available), grey trousers, shorts or grey skirt/grey pinafore dress (must be knee length), grey, black or white socks or grey, black, white or red tights and black school shoes.
