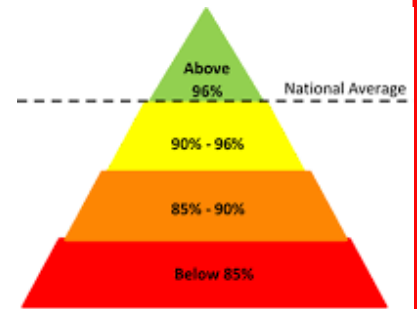

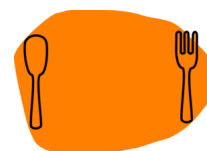

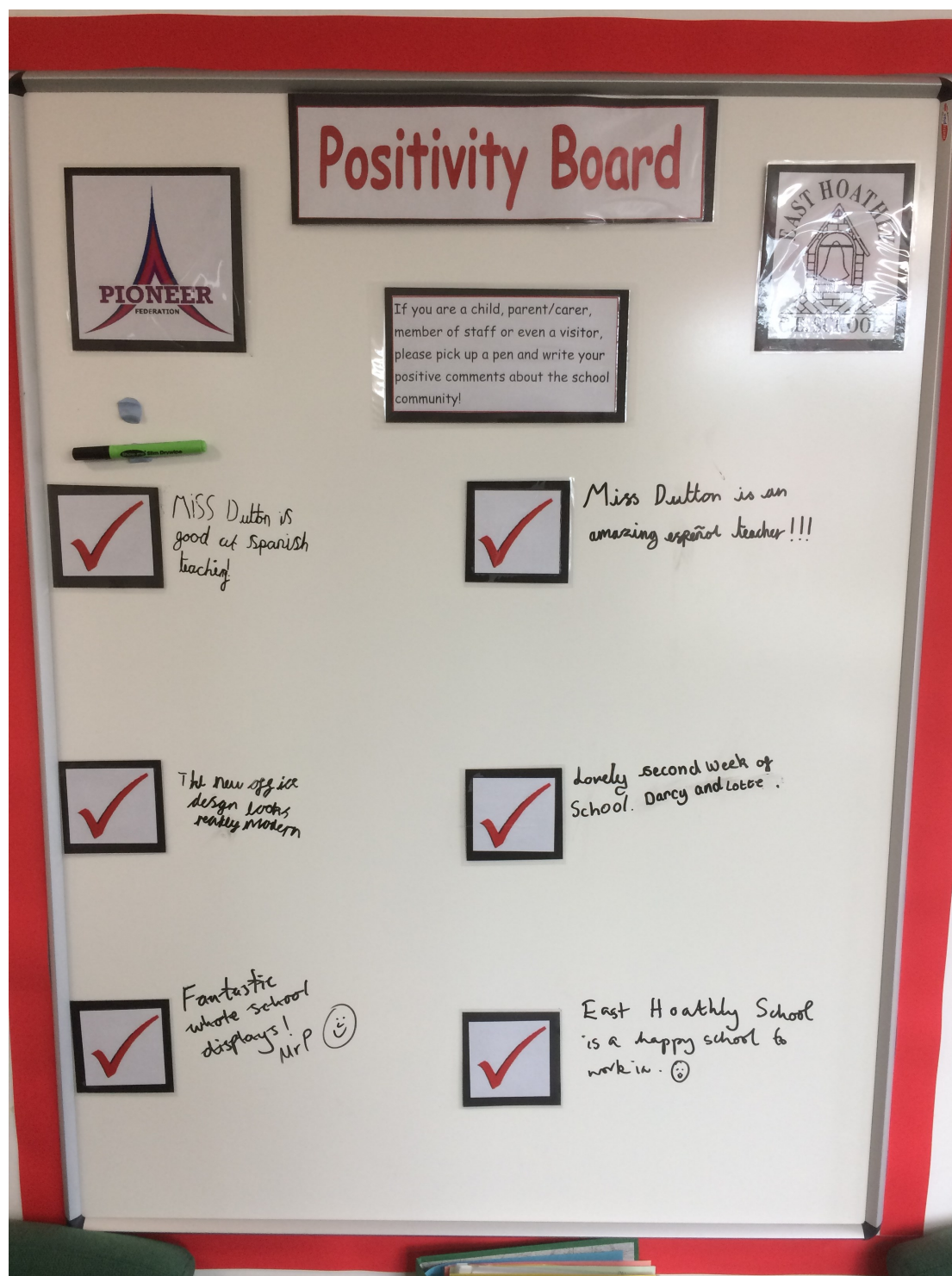
Positivity Board
