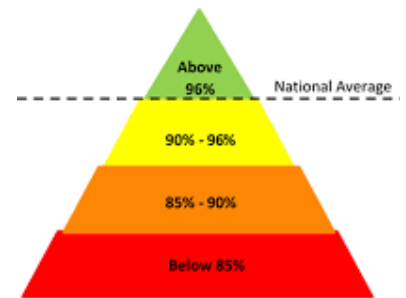

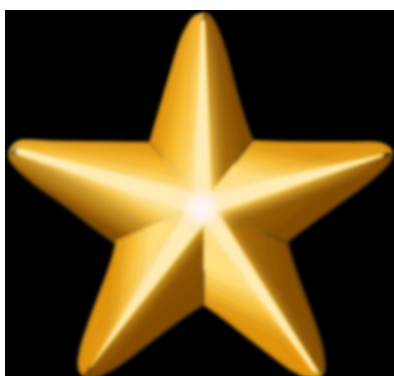


Headteacher's Award

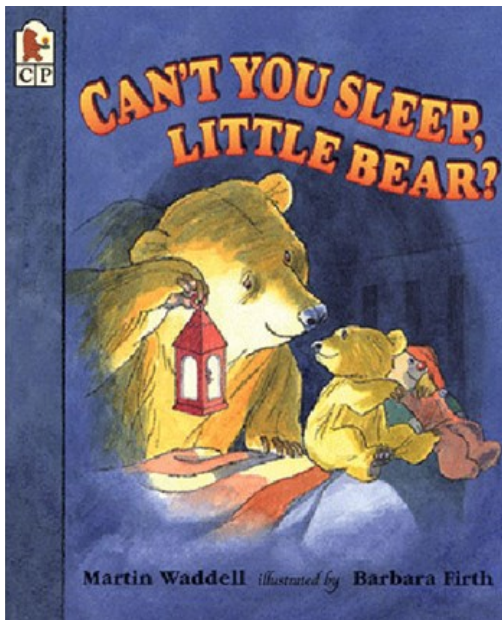


Nursery News
