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
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# End of Term Celebration


The whole school attendance for this year so far is: 97%


# P.A.Ls Assembly

Zach in Year 5 said that "Lorenzo's work is amazing. He remembered that he was learning about God."






# **MyMaths**








#### Governors

Please ensure you order no later than 21st October as otherwise you will need to send off your child's artwork yourself and will attract higher costs and postage.




# Nursery News
