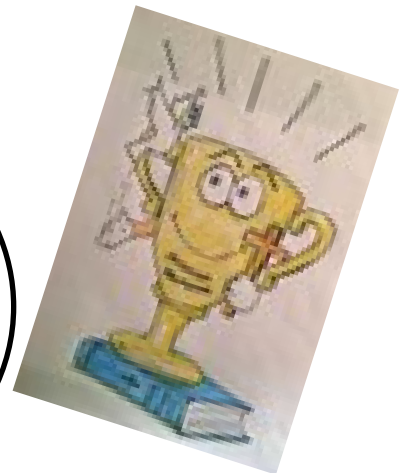
I am a Professor Brain because I could order all of the days of the week and some of the months in maths.

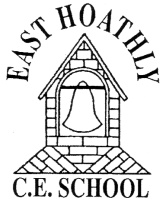

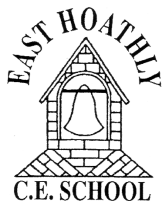

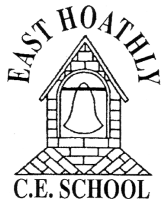
