


The whole school attendance for this year so far is: 96.4%







I am a Professor Brain because I could order all of the days of the week and some of the months in maths.




I think I'm a Growth Mindset Hero because I didn't think I'd be able to paint on a conker in art but I kept trying and managed to do it!


This week I have been a Growth Mindset Hero because in literacy I have been trying to make my handwriting neater and I think I have made some improvements!
