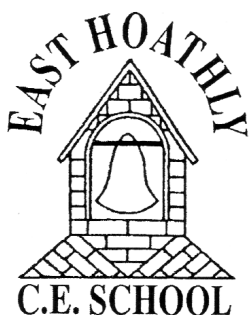
Thrive Forum

It was easy to see that they had practised it a lot, because they pulled it off flawlessly!

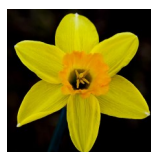
Not only were we treated to a great show, we managed to raise an impressive £146.31 for Comic Relief!
