The whole school attendance for this year so far is: **96.8%**

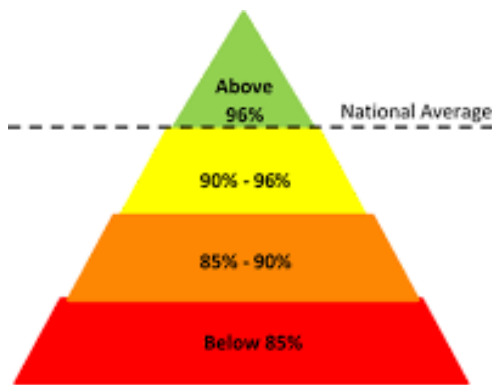
