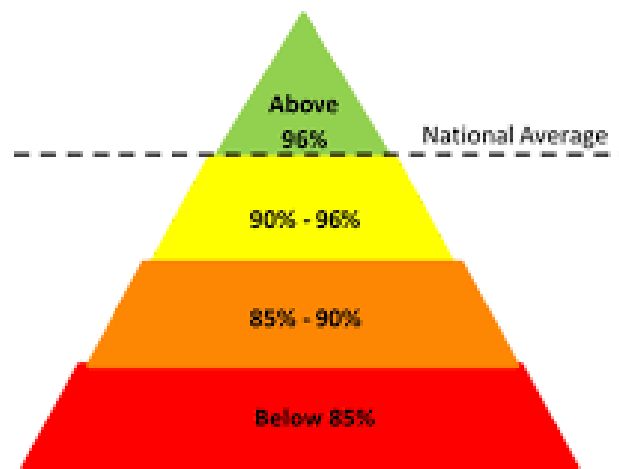

## More Information about the 6 Bs

At Pioneer, we want to give children the tools to become independent learners and help them to rely less on the adults in their classrooms, and more on themselves and their friends. The 6 Bs are strategies that the children can use before automatically asking an adult for help. By keeping calm, using their previous learning, their environment and their peers, children learn how to be independent and become more confident in their own ability to solve problems. The 6 Bs are also linked with our belief that having a growth mindset will help the children to achieve much more than they might think they are capable of!

When I'm stuck, I look at each B to help create an independent me!

## Wellbeing

This week's poster gives you 10 things to do if you are experiencing negative thoughts.

### 10 THINGS TO DO WHEN YOU START TO EXPERIENCE NEGATIVE THOUGHTS

@BELIEVEPHQ

- Ask yourself is the thought that I am experiencing fact or opinion?
- Once you have written down your thoughts look for the evidence for and against your thoughts
- Ask yourself "What would someone else say in this situation? What advice would I give to a friend or family member?"
- Take a breath and slow down. Try engaging in some deep breathing to reduce physiological and psychological arousal
- Try to come up with a more realistic or alternative perspective
- Understand the impact your thoughts have on your emotions, physical sensations and behaviours
- If you experience a negative thought try and refocus on what is you were doing
- Identify whether any of your thoughts can be categorised as a thinking error
- Write down your negative thoughts on a piece of paper
- Stay in the present moment. Engage all your senses to stay present

## Nursery News



This week in Nursery, we have continued with our story 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt'. The children have become very confident at re-enacting the story and sharing key phrases from the story, such as "We can't go over it! We can't go under it! Oh no! We've got to go through it!" The children had great fun acting out the story on the field, squelching through the mud in their wellies and pretending to walk through the 'swishy swashy grass'. Their favourite part was being chased by Harry the bear!

The children used paint and rollers to recreate the forest scenes from the book and during messy play, the children explored rainbow rice with hidden textures inside. The children enjoyed using tweezers to pick out the different textures and correctly match them up with their picture. Using tweezers is a really great way to help children develop their fine motor skills, which will help them with their writing skills when they are ready to start learning to write.

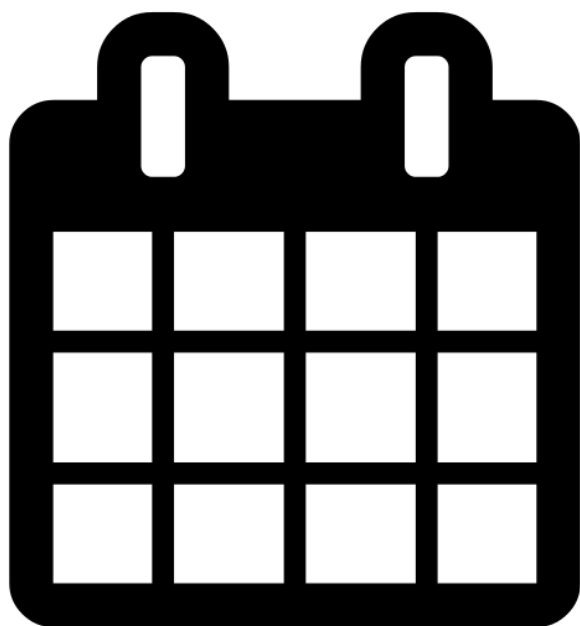
