

Poppy Ray for fantastic, independent and descriptive writing.


Buster Ray for a fantastic piece of art using printing independently.


Oliver - Reception


The book I am recommending is: 'Wave Me Goodbye' by Jacqueline Wilson




It's such a good book. The illustrations are amazing. I love reading this book and it is about evacuees and how this group of young children are looking around a small village for somewhere safe to stay.
