Once the children are back in school, the Pupil Governors will be reviewing the Child Friendly Anti-Bullying Policy and sharing it with their classes.

Other actions that have been taken towards the award is the work we did during Safer Internet Week, where staff, parents and pupils were all supported in developing their knowledge and understanding of online safety.

Our next steps are to develop the peer support groups (e.g. Playground Pals and Peer Mediators) in school to ensure they are established and effective.





Freya, you look like you enjoyed both making them and eating them! What a great little project—well done! Are you prepping to attend MasterChef any time soon, Freya?




Ezra from Hedgehog Class has been bustling around his house this week as he was on a phonics hunt!


