Reading	Please read with your child at least <b>three times a week</b> at home and ensure their reading record is signed and dated.

Grammar	Grammar homework is set <b>fortnightly</b> and will enable children to practise what they have been learning about in class.
Maths	Maths homework is set on MyMaths weekly.
Times tables	Please ensure that you continue to practice times tables with your child at home. It is important that they become confident with multiplication and division facts for the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Year 3</b> - 2, 10, 5, 3, 4, 8 times tables</li><li>• <b>Year 4</b> - In addition to the above 6, 7, 9, 11, and 12 times tables.</li></ul> <b>Times Tables Rockstars</b> is a great way to help your child develop instant recall.

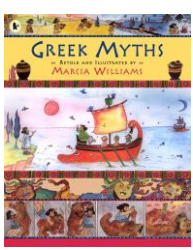
**PE** - Fox class have PE every Monday and Friday. Please ensure the children have their PE kit ready for these days.

If you have any questions or queries, please do not hesitate to ask.

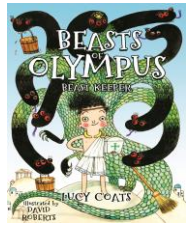
